

Redneck Race Rules and Classes

Mille Lacs County Fair

Registration: Pit gates open at 9:00 am. Participants please enter the south pit gate off of 1st Street. Registration is open from 10:00-11:30 am. Driver's meeting at 11:30 am in the pits. All vehicles must pass a pre-race inspection.

Drivers must be 16 years or older with a valid driver's license.

Drivers 16-18 years must have a parent's signature on the waiver.

Fees: Registration fee is \$25 and includes 1 pit pass. Additional pit passes are \$25.

Course Info: Course will include jumps and obstacles, to be described in detail at the driver's meeting. 5 laps for heat races and 10 for feature, subject to change and will be communicated at drivers meeting. Drivers will be provided the opportunity to complete up to 2 laps to familiarize themselves with the course layout. Practice laps will be strictly non-contact.

Staging Plan: Starting order will be determined by random draw. Staging officials will assist in line-up at the "on-ramp", located on the south end of the track. Starting officials will wait for a "thumbs up" from each driver before beginning the race.

Classes: Classes may be combined if insufficient entries are received in a particular class

1. Small Car: 4 cylinder, front wheel drive
2. Large Car: 6 & 8 cylinder stock, front or rear wheel drive
3. Small Truck: ¼ ton or smaller pick-up trucks, must be rear wheel drive or front drive shaft must be removed
4. Large Truck: ½ ton or larger pick-up trucks, full-size vans; must be rear wheel drive or front drive shaft must be removed
5. Minivan/SUV: front or rear wheel drive

Mechanical Rules:

- Vehicles must have a number painted on doors and roof. Number must be visible from both sides of vehicle
- Stock suspension (no performance shocks, may not change mounting locations)
- Tires must be street legal, mudflaps encouraged
- Bumpers must be stock or stock-appearing
- Hitches must be removed
- Tow points should be located on front and rear of vehicle

- Front oil pan and radiator shielding allowed
- Battery must be tied down and covered
- Airbags must be removed
- Radiators may be relocated but must be mounted securely
- Alternative fuel cells are permissible and should be mounted with safety in mind

Safety Requirements:

- Seat belts including shoulder straps must be worn.
- Roll cages are strongly encouraged.
- Glass must be removed. Windshields are permitted.
- Driver's side window must have a safety net.
- Doors must be in place and remain shut at all times (must be chained or welded)
- All loose items must be removed from vehicle (inside and out)
- Helmets must be worn at all times on the track.
- Do not exit a stalled vehicle until instructed by track officials
- Vehicles must have a mounted fire extinguisher.
- No hitting on drivers door
- No alcohol allowed in the pits. Absolutely no consumption of drugs or alcohol by drivers.
- Only authorized personnel will be allowed on the track
- Aggressive dangerous driving will not be tolerated
- Unsportsmanlike conduct and violation of rules will result in disqualification. All decisions by track officials are final. Participants may be disqualified at any time with no refund of entry fee.

Flagging: Standard race flagging

Green: Indicates start of race, also end of caution

Yellow: Caution, hazard on track, drivers must slow and not pass

Red: Drivers must come to a complete stop

White: Indicates the beginning of final lap of race

Checkered: Race completion

Pointed black flag: Warning

Black waved flag: Disqualification (mechanical problems, unsportsmanlike conduct), driver to return to pit immediately
