2025 Tractor Pull Classes and Rules - Mille Lacs County Fair

Farmer's Classes:

- Factory-appearing or stock replacement block, carburetor, injector pump, turbo, front end, and drivetrain for that make and model
- All tractors must have fenders and floor plate
- Tractors must be factory stock appearing
- Wide front ends are strongly encouraged
- No block spacers
- Governor required
- Maximum 3000 RPM for all turbo classes
- Only one fuel type
- No cut tires
- 16.9-38 max tire size for 5,500 lbs and below
- 18.4-38 max tire size for 6,500 lbs 9,500 lbs
- Duals are allowed with a minimum of 6 bolts per hub, starting at 10,500 lbs
- All engine fans must be factory or shrouded steel 1/16" or thicker
- All transmissions and clutch housings covered.
- Turbos are allowed in classes 10,500 lbs and up
- All turbo not under a hood must be completely shrouded except for an inlet and exhaust pipe 1/16" or thicker

4,500 lb- 3 MPH speed limit	10,500 lb- no speed limit
5,500 lb- 3 MPH speed limit	12,500 lb- no speed limit
6,500 lb- 4 MPH speed limit	14,500 lb- no speed limit

Improved Farm Classes:

3,500 lbs, 4,000 lbs, 5,000 lbs, 6,000 lbs, 7,000 lbs, 8,000 lbs & 12,500 lbs

RULES FOR 3,500 lbs, 4,000 lbs, 5,000 lbs, 6,000 lbs, 7,000 lbs, & 8,000 lbs IMPROVED CLASSES

- 5 MPH Speed Limit
- No turbo unless factory equipped
- Engine must be stock or ag based replacement with same number of cylinders as factory
- Safety equipment is strongly encouraged
- Fenders are strongly encouraged
- Headers allowed
- Updraft carburetor unless originally equipped without
- Factory style injection pump if diesel
- Working governors required If using a rev limiter it must be set to a maximum of 3000 RPMs
- 16.9-38 max tire size for 4,000 lbs and below
- 18.4-38 max tire size for 5,000 lbs and above
- Top cut tires allowed

- No full cuts
- No dual tires

RULES FOR 12,500 Ib IMPROVED CLASS

- No speed limit
- One fuel
- No injectables
- No dual tires

Open Classes:

7,000 lbs & 9,000 lbs

RULES FOR OPEN CLASSES:

- Must have a safety blanket on the clutch and flywheel
- Wheelie bars required
- Must have a break away switch and second emergency shut off within reach of the driver
- Factory appearing block
- Exhaust pipe must be cross-bolted
- Front dampener covered
- Wide front must track within the rear wheels, minimum of 60 inches
- Roll over protection and dead man throttle required
- Helmet and fire suit are MANDATORY
- 9,000 lb class may have 1 turbo only, any size
- 3 x 4 turbos allowed
- Cut tires allowed
- One fuel only (gas, propane, diesel)
- No nitrous or oxidizers
- Quick releasing side panels, removable for inspection, are required
- Fuel shutoff required between pump and fuel filter

Super Antique Class:

5,500 lbs

RULES FOR SUPER ANTIQUE CLASS:

- 12 MPH
- Wide front end is strongly encouraged
- Must have an updraft carburetor unless originally equipped without
- Fenders are required
- Wheelie Bars are required
- Headers are allowed
- Any cut tire allowed
- Safety equipment is strongly encouraged
- No dual tires
