THESE RULES ARE FOR 2025

❖ General Event Rules

- There will be no arguing or fights with any member of staff, we have the right to eject and ban anyone at any time during the event. We understand tensions get high, but we have a general respect for drivers, and we expect the same in return.
- No alcoholic beverages in the pits, staging, or show area before, during, or after the derby. Subject to disqualification.
- Your pit area must be clean and free of debris after the event. Clean up to the best of your ability. An inability to clean up after yourself may result in not being able to participate in future events.
- All cars must be removed from the facility the night of the derby. There will be a \$300 charge enforced if you leave your vehicle at the facility!
- No hot rodding in the pits, keep it at an idle.
- All cars must remain in the designated pit area. Mechanical work done on cars in the pit area only.
- All Classes are allowed to have 1 passenger in the front passenger seat.
- All drivers/passengers must be 16 years or older and have a **valid driver's license, and both parents' signatures on permission form.**
- In shows with a power wheels class, 3–11-year-olds must have **both parents' signature on permission form.**

☐ **NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 is allowed in the pits unless they are a driver!!**

- Registration on the day of the event is from 12:00 PM to 5:30 PM. You need to be registered and passed re-tech by 5:30pm or you will not run, no exceptions! Driver's meeting will be at 6:00PM. All vehicles must be completely registered before inspection can occur. Inspection must be done off the trailer. Drivers only at inspection.
- Registration fees for all classes is \$75. Pit passes are \$25 each. Pit passes are required by all individuals in the pits. If under 18, you must have both parent's or guardian's signature. If you are loaded or ejected for any reason, entry fee money is not returned!
- Social Security number may be required to collect winnings.
- All Drivers and Crew Members must attend the drivers meeting.

❖ **On Track Rules**

- No intentional holding or tag teaming, subject for disqualification. Only warning given is in the drivers meeting.
- No intentional hitting of driver's doors or passenger door if passenger is riding., subject for disqualification.
- No hitting a person with a stick down, subject for disqualification.
- All drivers/passengers are required to wear seat belts, a safety helmet, and eye protection. A neck brace is recommended.
- You will be allowed one fire, after the second fire you will be disqualified.
- All cars must make an aggressive/legal hit within 1 minute or they will be timed out. Aggressive hits means other car moves minimum of 6".
- Drivers full body must remain in the vehicle for the duration of the event, except for fires or emergencies.
- Intentional sandbagging will not be tolerated, subject for disqualification.
- No movement on a red flag, we understand a car may have brake issues but if you are moving to gain better position you will be disqualified.

County Fair 2025 General Rules

❖ **General Build Rules**

- **Street stock Rules- Any American make car can run with the following exceptions: NO 1970 or older Lincolns and NO 1973 or older Chrysler Imperials or Imperial sub-frames, 4x4, ambulance, hearses, trucks, limousines, frames or full cars etc...**
- **MWFA Rules – Any 1980 and newer 2 wheel drive passenger car/mini-van/mini-truck/mid-size suv**

➤ **Midsized Super Stock -Any American or foreign made car can run with the following exceptions: all vehicles must be FWD or RWD, 6 cylinder or less, and under 108" wheelbase. If you are unsure about the vehicle being eligible for class, ask.**

➤ **Man-Van and light suv- Any mass-produced minivan suv, FWD or RWD ONLY, NO AWD, 4 or 6 Cylinders only**

➤ **Bonestock class- Any American made car can run with the following exceptions; Pre 70s Lincoln or Mercury, Pre-73 Chrysler Imperial, 03 or newer FOMO CO, 4x4's, ambulance, hearses, trucks, or limousines.**

➤ **Limited weld trucks-1/2 – 3/4-ton American made pickup, extended, crew cabs, or suburbans are allowed.**

➤ **IF THE RULES DO NOT SAY YOU CAN DO IT THEN YOU CAN'T!**

➤ NO welding other than what is mentioned in this set of rules. If your car is found with any weld, other than what is specified, and you refuse to fix it to the judge's satisfaction, you and your car will not run!!

➤ No profanity allowed on cars, subject to disqualification.

➤ No Fresh Paint or Undercoating on the frames at all. No buffing or grinding frames or bodies except where welding is specifically allowed in these rules.

➤ All cars must be stock unless modifications are stated in the rules.

➤ All glass, plastic, chrome, and interior must be removed from car before arriving to the derby.

➤ All trailer hitches and braces must be removed.

➤ Batteries and fuel tank must be moved to the passenger compartment near the driver. They must be properly secured and covered.

➤ You must have a 15"x15" sign on the roof of your car with car number on it for judging and recognition of the car. You cannot use the roof sign to strengthen the car.

➤ All cars must have working brakes when you come to inspection. If the car is not able to exhibit the ability to stop it will not be inspected.

➤ Forklift tires, skid loader tires, and bobcat tires are allowed on drive and steer tires.

➤ Judges decisions are FINAL!!

If you build outside the rules plan on bringing a torch and a welder!!!!!!
