

Truck Pull General Rules Mille Lacs County Fair

1. Sportsmanship Rule: Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. It will result in a suspension of a year and one day.
2. All drivers will pull at their own risk. The Mille Lacs County Agricultural Society is not responsible for breakage of equipment, accidents or injury.
3. Contest is governed by the officials, with all the official's decisions final. Officials have the right to stop and disqualify participants at any time. Failure to obey track officials will result in disqualification. Officials may examine any part of the entered truck. If disqualified any entry fees will not be refunded.
4. Everyone in the pits including drivers must purchase a pit band at the pit gate AND sign the waiver. Pullers will get one hook fee covered with their pit band.
5. Only one hook per truck. No first re-pull option.
6. Drivers must be 16 years of age and must show a valid driver's license at registration. All drivers ages 16 and 17 must have a parent or legal guardian's signature on waiver. Parents assume all responsibility, subject to the official's decisions.
7. NO passengers in or on vehicles during the pull.
8. All weight classes are with the driver. 50 lb grace.
9. Trucks must be operated in a safe manner at all times. No chain jerking or hot-rodding allowed. May result in disqualification.
10. Your truck and the sled must stay within the boundaries of the track. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
11. Loss of weights, hitch or anything else that would cause a safety issue during pulling will result in disqualification.
12. Weights, weight bracket, and support wheels must not exceed 60" from the center of the axle with the exception of the 3" ring for pushing or pulling the truck.
13. Hitch must be frame mounted only. No trick hitches or floating hitches. The hitch must be rigid or solid in all directions at all times. All pullers must furnish their own clevis or 3" wide X 3.75" deep hole. The 3" X 3.75" opening must be horizontal to the ground. No vertical hitches.

14. The only fuel allowed is what is specified by the vehicle manufacturer.
15. You can only protest another truck and driver if they are in the class you pull in. Protest must be entered before the next class. Protest fee may apply.
16. The use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is not permitted in the pit area at any time.
17. No refunds for pit bands or grandstand entrance will be provided in the event the pull is canceled early due to rain/severe weather. Thank you for your cooperation.
18. Pulling order will be designated at registration. Truck must pull in assigned position within 3 minutes or be subject to disqualification. Judges may reposition you.
19. Changes or rearranging of weights after weigh in will result in disqualification.
20. Please place truck in neutral or park with hands in the air while being hooked and unhooked.
21. No electronic traction control devices allowed in any class.
22. All general rules apply to all truck classes. Tech and track officials have final say. Anyone who is disrespectful, displays unsportsmanlike conduct, or jeopardizes the safety of themselves or others will be disqualified.
23. No exhibition pulls allowed.
