Official Rules and Regulations**

Entry and Check-In Information

- **Entry Deadlines:** All entries shall be made through Showman. Entry fee is \$20 per animal. Entries must be received online by Friday, August 7th, 2026, to enter without paying the late entry fees. A \$10 late fee will be applied for same day registrations. No refunds will be available. The Mille Lacs County Youth Livestock Foundation reserves the right to reject any entry.
- **Exhibitor Eligibility:** No exhibitor age requirement. Show is open to youth and adults.
- Gates will open on Saturday, August 8th, 2026 at 7:00 AM. Animals will be brought in for the day of show only, unless already participating in Mille Lacs County 4-H sheep or goat exhibition.
- **Check-In/Weigh-In:** All exhibitors must check in before the show. Check-in will be from 8:00-9:00 am on Saturday, August 8th, 2026. All sheep and goats must be weighed prior to check-in.
- Show will begin at 10:00 AM in the Livestock Pavilion

General Information

- Stalling: This will be a trailer show. Stalling will not be available. Exhibitors will be expected to clean up around their trailer and parking area. Please take your manure and trash with you in your trailer. Bedding will not be supplied.
- Please enter the fairgrounds through the North gate along the cemetery (at the intersection of 13th Ave N & 5th St. N). Trailer parking spots will be assigned in designated areas.
- Admission is included for only the registered exhibitor. All others will need to purchase a wristband for fair entrance.
- Wash rack and water are available. Electrical plug-ins will not be provided, please bring a generator.
- Only service dogs are allowed on the Mille Lacs County Fairgrounds.
- No "for sale" signs are allowed to be displayed.
- All decisions of Mille Lacs County Youth Livestock Foundation show personnel and the official judges will be final. The show committee reserves the right to change or modify rules as deemed necessary.
- Payouts will be given to the top five placing sheep and top five placing goats.

Vet Requirements

- All livestock will be subject to an examination by the official show veterinarian on the day of arrival.
- Health papers are not required for livestock originating from Minnesota. Animals from out of state will need health papers and a copy will be collected at check-in.
- **Official IDs** are required for all sheep and goats exhibited in Minnesota as specified by the Minnesota Board of Animal Health.

Exhibitor Liability and Ethics

Exhibitors are required to carry their own liability insurance. All livestock exhibited in this show will be exhibited entirely at the owner's risk. Upon entering the Mille Lacs County Youth Livestock Foundation Jackpot Sheep & Goat Show, the exhibitor agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Mille Lacs County Youth Livestock Foundation, its officers and membership as well as the Mille Lacs County Agricultural Society and its directors from any and all claims, demands, suits, actions, losses, costs or expenses, including attorney's fees arising in whole or in part out of the negligent acts, errors or omissions of you, your agent, or invitees. Entry to the show shall be deemed acceptance of these rules and the IAFE Code of Ethics. No unethical oral, injected or physical altering material will be allowed on any animal at the show. All exhibitors violating this rule will be disqualified.

Classes

- **Sheep Market Wether:** Must be born on or after December 1st, 2025. Classes may be split by weight, depending on the number of entries. Black face/white face/speckleds will show together.
- **Wether Dam Ewe Lamb:** Must be born on or after December 1st, 2025. Classes may be split by weight, depending on the number of entries. Black face/white face/speckleds will show together.
- **Goat Wether:** Must be born between November 1st, 2025 and April 30th, 2026. Classes may be split by weight, depending on the number of entries.
- **Goat Wether Dam Kid:** Must be born between September 1st, 2025 and April 30th, 2026. Classes may be split by weight, depending on the number of entries.
